Mission Statement:

Inspired by the Daughters of Charity and the De La Salle Christian Brothers, in partnership with families, Sacred Heart Cathedral Preparatory's mission is to provide the finest education in an inclusive Catholic community of faith. Sacred Heart Cathedral Preparatory (SHC) is a Lasallian Vincentian Catholic, co-educational college preparatory secondary school located in the heart of San Francisco, California. We provide academically rigorous, vibrant learning grounded in social justice and student-centered pedagogy. Our community is committed to cultivating each student's unique abilities and passions, and to facilitating opportunities for students to discern and realize their individual intellectual, artistic, athletic, social, and spiritual potential. SHC is a San Francisco Archdiocesan High School that is cosponsored by the De La Salle Christian Brothers of the District of San Francisco and the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul of the Province of the West.

As an inclusive Catholic community of faith, we respect and support our students, faculty, and staff and their sense of belonging in an increasingly diverse world. At SHC, such respect is grounded by our mission and carried out through our Lasallian Vincentian Catholic educational traditions. Position Summary

The Associate Director of Campus Ministry, under the direction of the Director of Campus Ministry and the Assistant Principal for Student Life, designs, prepares, implements, and evaluates retreat opportunities for the school community that support both individual and community spiritual growth and exploration of Christian living. This individual coordinates and facilitates student retreats and shares this responsibility with the Director of Campus Ministry. The Coordinator, in collaboration with the Campus Ministry Team, coordinates and promotes opportunities that develop, support and nurture the faith lives of the SHC community, and animate the mission of the school, the charisms of its founders, and the mission of the Catholic church. It is a full-time position.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Mission:

- Invests in the mission of SHC and the charisms of the Daughters of Charity and De La Salle Christian Brothers through active Catholic mission formation.

Retreats

- Actively develops and implements retreats that animate the school's mission and that fosters the Lasallian Vincentian Catholic mission in the life of the students.
- Recruits students, faculty, and staff to be part of the leadership of the retreat program and provides training and formation for these individuals. Collaborates with the Director of Campus Ministry to ensure the success of this program. This responsibility includes attending and participating in the Campus Ministry Student Leadership Retreat.
- Coordinates and facilitates Kairos and Frosh retreats in collaboration with the Director of Campus Ministry.
- Coordinates the Faculty/Staff Retreats in collaboration with other Campus Ministry Team members and the SHC Mission Formation Group.
- Collaborates with other Campus Ministry Team members and SHC staff to provide support for retreats including: ordering supplies, arranging transportation, coordinating meals, and crafting a budget.
- Supports the facilitation and coordination of Junior and Sophomore retreats in collaboration with the Director of Campus Ministry.

Other

- Collaborates with other Campus Ministry Team members to advance the mission of the school.
- Attends all Campus Ministry Team meetings.
- Participates in opportunities for professional development.
- Attends programs of the Office of Young Lasallians for the District of San Francisco-New Orleans.
- Assists the Director of Campus Ministry with other duties as needed.

- A practicing Roman Catholic who will embrace, embody, and promote the Lasallian Vincentian Catholic mission of SHC.
- Experience working with high school students.
- Experience with facilitating retreats.
- Undergraduate or graduate degree in theology.
- Ability to work collaboratively and independently to facilitate faith formation.

- Experience as a campus minister and/or a theology or religious studies teacher.
- Administrative and managerial experience.
- Experience overseeing a student retreat program, including Kairos.
