QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's or advanced degree with teacher's certificate preferred. Previous head coaching experience is preferred, but not required. The ideal candidate will have a strong history of character and adult staff development. The head boys cross country coach must realize and appreciate the need for the program to work with other sports as a complement to the entire athletic department, as well as a demonstrated commitment to the ideals of Catholic and Jesuit education. If a teaching or position is open in the school fitting a candidate's credentials, the coaching candidate may apply separately for that position if interested. All applicants must have a current resume with a fully completed application as directed below.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Ability to be available, organize and supervise practice sessions, off-season workouts, and other activities that pertain to a complete cross country program including, but not limited to, coordinating summer camps as directed by the Athletic Department.
2. Support the school's Athletic Philosophy, particularly as it pertains to:
 - a. Athletic Code of Conduct
 - b. Formation
 - c. Academic Focus
 - d. Athletic Development
3. Provide locker room supervision
4. Hire and oversee assistant coaches within the guidelines of the athletic department mission and handbook
5. Attend all mandated Saint Ignatius/CCL/IHSA meetings and training sessions
6. Responsible for inventory, distribution and collection of uniforms and equipment
7. Maintain appropriate relationships and boundaries with student/athlete, parents, etc
