



Job Posting High School Physics Teacher

Job Summary: McQuaid Jesuit, a Catholic school in Rochester, NY, teaching boys' grades 6-12, is seeking a full-time high school Physics teacher. Ideal applicants have graduate degrees in Physics or Education/Science, prior teaching experience in high school and a willingness to promote all areas of Jesuit education. Ability to plan, organize and implement an appropriate instructional program in a secondary learning environment working in collaboration with a department leader, Dean of Academics, and the high school principal.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Plan, prepare and deliver lesson plans and instructional materials to develop student learning.
- Follow established teaching procedures in line with a Jesuit education.
- Instruct and mentor students.
- Use school provided technology to help deliver learning materials.
- Follow school disciplinary rules for maintaining the code of conduct within the classroom and school grounds.
- Provide timely and productive feedback to students.
- Maintain school student records and grades in a timely and appropriate manner.
- Participate in department, school, and professional development

Additional Responsibilities

- Other duties as assigned

Competencies/Skills

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills (both oral and written) are required.
- Ability to work both independently and in a collaborative environment.
- Familiarity with McQuaid Jesuit's Catholic, Jesuit mission is preferred.

- Bachelor's Degree in Science or Education with a concentration in Physics, a minimum of 3 – 5 years of experience in teaching preferred
- Master's Degree preferred, prior background and experience in Jesuit secondary education preferred.
